A ROOM WITH A VIEW (PG)

(1985) 1h 57m Drama | Romance

In its way, one of the most influential British films of the 80s, *A Room With A View* defined forevermore what a prestige costume drama should be, winning 5 BAFTAs plus 3 Oscars and making production team Merchant Ivory a byword for quality and class. The source is perhaps E M Forster's greatest novel, which tells the emotional awakening of a young Englishwoman while holidaying in Italy. The film is the coming together of many great talents - the luminous youth of Daniel Day-Lewis, Julian Sands and (in her first feature film) Helena Bonham-Carter, shedding their Edwardian oppressions amidst the sumptuous, sunny beauty of Florence in full bloom.

MOULIN ROUGE! (12A)

(2001) 2h 7m Drama | Musical | Romance

Moulin Rouge! is director Baz Luhrmann's magnum opus, where his gloriously rich and vibrant style reaches its zenith. It tells a tall tale from the legendary fin-de-siecle Paris cabaret club, where naive but optimistic poet Christian (Ewan McGregor) falls for the lead chanteuse Satine (Nicole Kidman). Brimming with music, the film cleverly uses well-known modern pop songs as a kind of emotional shorthand for the lovers' narrative. A whirligig of colour and song, this is one of the most purely romantic films ever made, with McGregor and Kidman making an outrageously attractive screen couple for the ages.
