### Who are we?

BAE design, manufacture, and support complex surface ships, submarines, torpedoes, radars, and command and combat systems. We also provide ship repair, maintenance and upgrade services, and are a supplier of naval systems, as well as being a provider of commercial shipbuilding.

The Maritime Sector, takes many forms – from an innovation that keeps people safe at sea, to services and support solutions which maintain military capability, to high-end complex defence assets and to facilities and platforms which provide a home away from home for service personnel for months at a time.

### What can I expect?

On this one week program students will develop their skills and experience through virtual live sessions and online activities.
